- The cost per person varies depending on which platter menu you go for, a non-refundable, non-transferable deposit of **€100.00** per party is required to confirm your booking which will be subtracted from the final bill, or handed back to the party on the night, this deposit is to hold the reservation.

The deposit must be paid within 10 working days of the date of your booking or your party reservation will be cancelled.

Deposits paid for no-shows will not be refunded

Final numbers and Platter options must be confirmed 5 working days prior to the night of booking.

Confirming Bookings

- No Booking is confirmed until we receive an e-mail saying you agree to abide by these conditions. You will then receive an e-mail from a member of the management team to confirm your booking.

- Charges and Tabs - We at Break for the Border do not charge for reserving an area. You only pay for your food and drink.

- A tab system using drink vouchers can be used. This can be done in two ways:
 1. Voucher is assigned a cash value (eg. €6.00) This means that if a drink costs €5.00 you get €1.00 change but if it costs €7.00 you must pay €1.00 extra. This system makes it easier to budget for your party as you know exactly how much you will spend
 2. Voucher is assigned a "drink value". This means a voucher can buy a Pint / Bottle / Spirit and Mixer / Glass of Wine. This system means no customers will have to pay extra but due to differing prices for different drinks, budgeting is harder

- Break for the Border can supply drinks vouchers for your party if required, please give us **one week notice** prior to booking if you require company logo on vouchers please supply.

- At all times when a tab is running we ask that a credit card **MUST** be behind the bar to act as security

- We would ask that all tabs are paid on the night of booking.

Reserved Areas

- We do not guarantee SPECIFIC areas for parties. You will be allocated an area by management which fits in best with the size of your group and the number of bookings on the night.
- Booking an area for instance 40 people does not mean seats for 40 people. This is not practical as Break for the Border has a capacity of approx 1000 but only has seating for approx 300. Every effort will be made by management to give you the best and most comfortable area for your party.
- Management will not enter into discussions on the night about changing the area as you will already have been given the best possible area.

Booking Times & Queues

- Your area will be reserved for 1 hour from time of the booking. After this time all signs will be removed. The onus is on you and your party to fill the area. We cannot have wasted empty areas at Christmas time as it is unfair to other customers who have arrived without a booking but are unable to find table/seats due to people not arriving for a booking. Again, management will not enter into discussion about this on the night.
- People attending a booking do not have to queue for entry provided they arrive within one hour of booking time. People arriving after this time will have to queue like all regular customers. If the venue is full to capacity, customers will be refused entry whether with a booking or not (if arriving more than one hour after booking). No exceptions.

Conditions of Entry

- Break for the Border operates a strict over 21's policy. Nobody under this age will be admitted, whether with a booking or not. We accept Garda ID card, Drivers Licences or Passports ONLY as proof of age. We ask that people under 25 have proof of age with them
- All patrons must be sober on entering the premises.
- Neat Dress is essential.
- Management reserve the right to refuse.
- Management and Security are not obliged to provide a reason for refusal
- Discussions about refusals will not be entered into on the night. Each member of a group is treated as an individual before gaining entry. If one person out of a group of 30 people is drunk/underage/refused entry for another reason, then they will not be admitted just because they happen to be part of a booking.

And Finally...

There may seem to be a lot of conditions here, and some may seem very strict, but we simply try to enforce these so that the management and staff can give you the best possible experience on the night. Once everybody is aware of the conditions in advance, the night itself will run a lot smoother for everyone.
